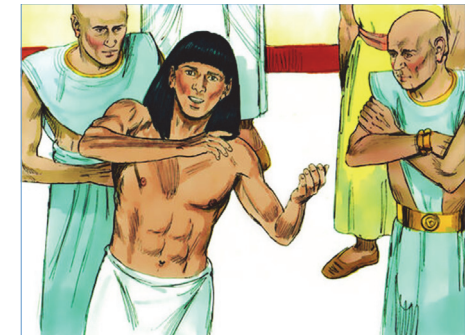
That night they both had dreams. In the morning they told their dreams to Joseph.

The Pharaoh called Joseph from prison. Joseph said, "Your dream is from God. He will send seven good years, then seven years of famine. You need to prepare for the famine."



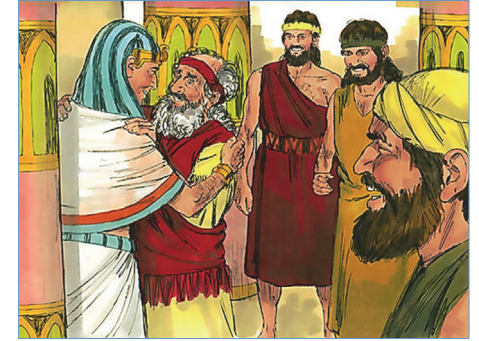

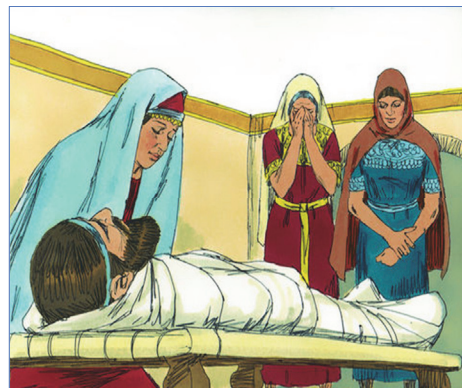
Sometimes God's people forgot him and broke his laws. Then God would send famine or war.
