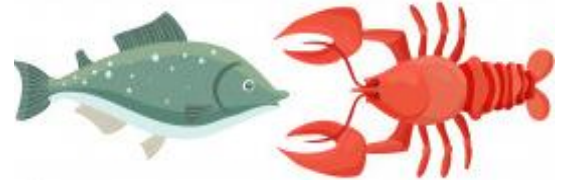

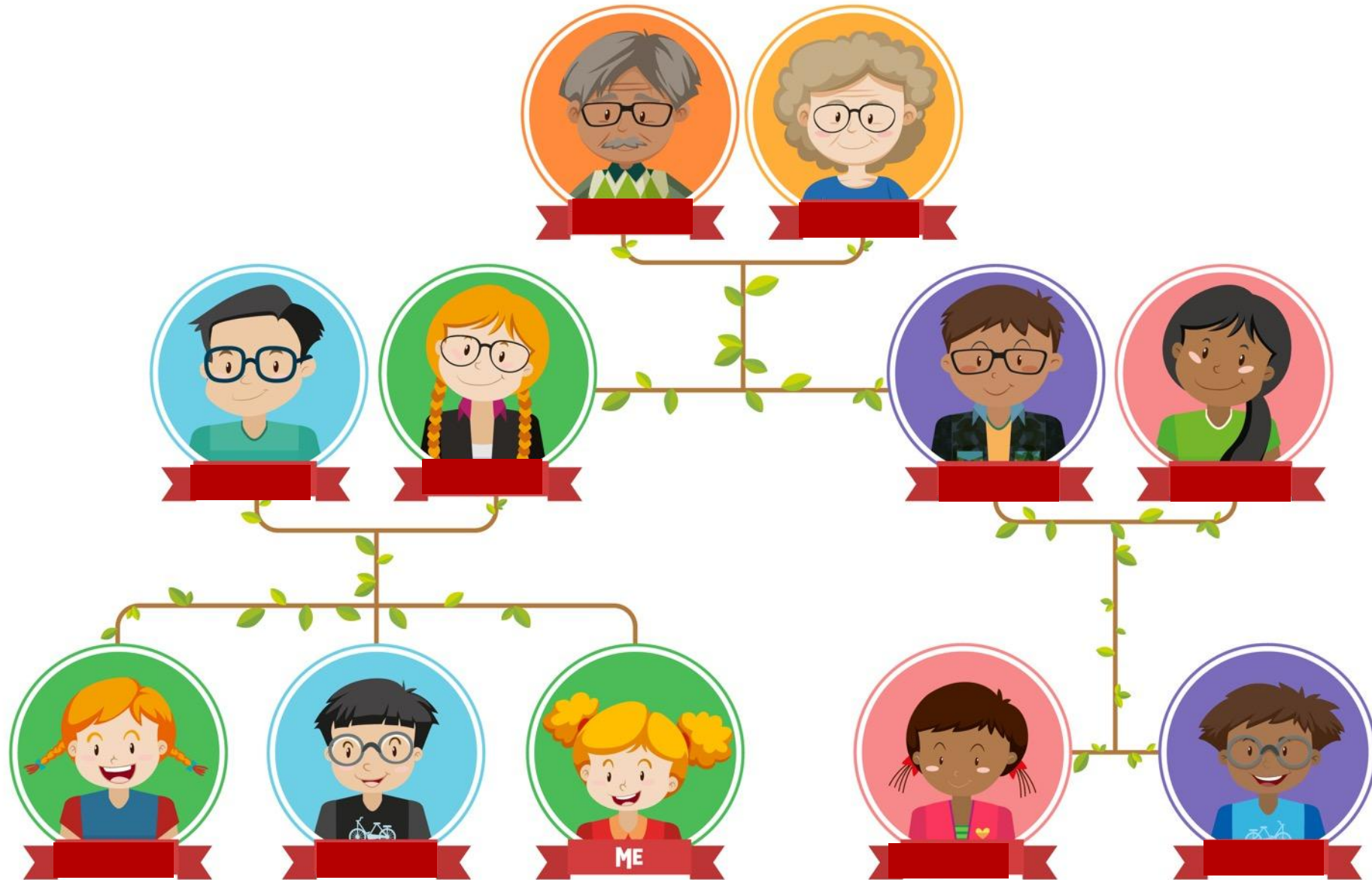

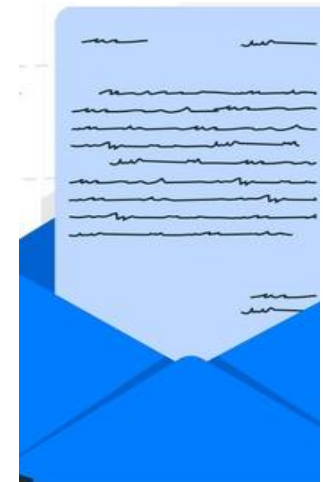

# Countable and Uncountable Nouns.

Amount	Countable	Uncountable
+++++++	They see <b>a lot of</b> angels.	He has <b>a lot of</b> coffee.
+++	They see <b>a few</b> angels.	He has <b>a little</b> coffee.
1	They see an angel.	-
0	They don't see <b>any</b> angels.	He doesn't have <b>any</b> coffee.

# Present Simple Tense

Subject	Verb
I You We They The children	wake up make breakfast work brush watch TV
He She It John The boy	wakes up makes breakfast works brushes watches TV



# 3rd Person Present Irregular Verbs

I You We They	have lunch do homework go to bed.
He She It John The girl	<b>has</b> lunch. <b>does</b> homework. <b>goes</b> to bed.
