Philip teaches about Jesus

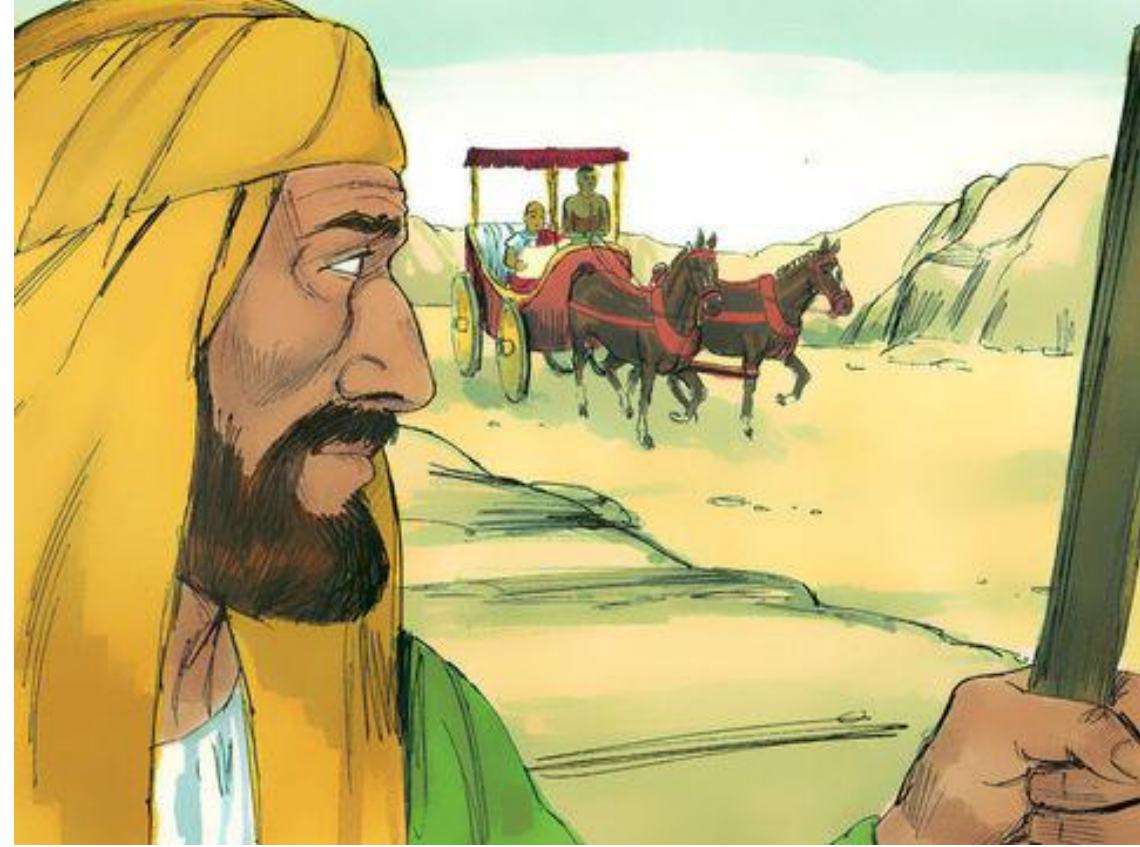
Acts 8:1-8, 26-40

A man named Philip was another believer. He preached about Jesus. Many people listened to him. He did great things for God.





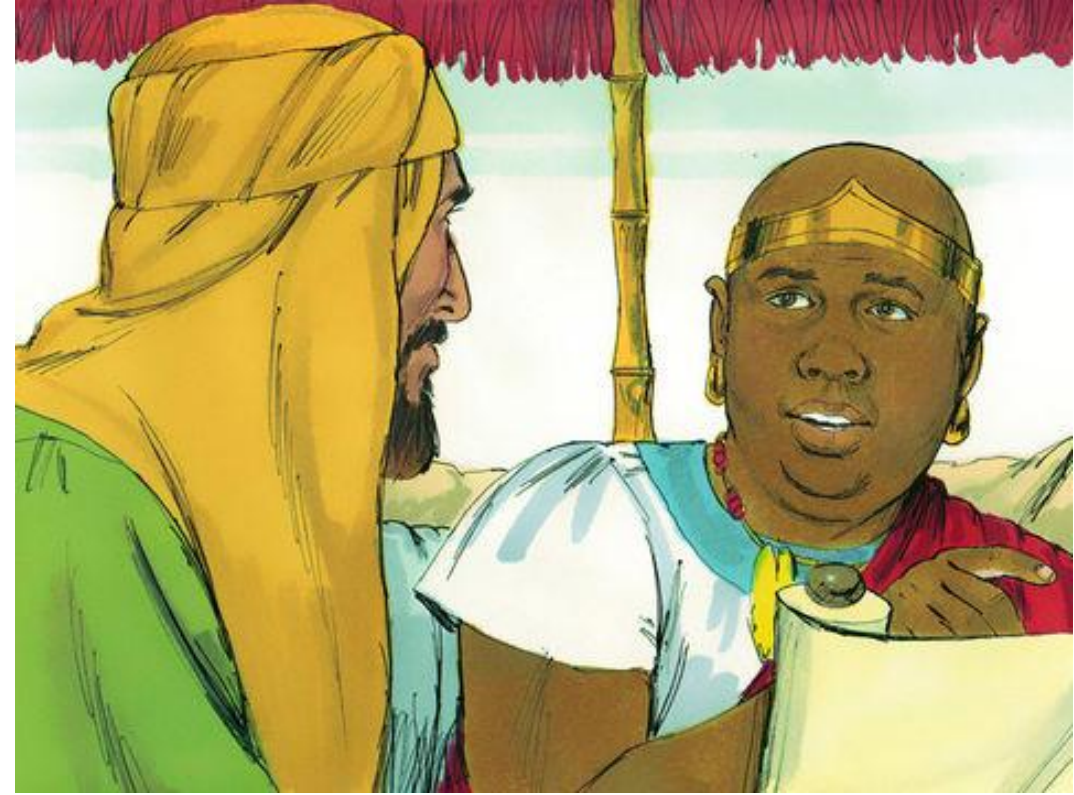

Philip asked the man, "Do you know what you are reading?"

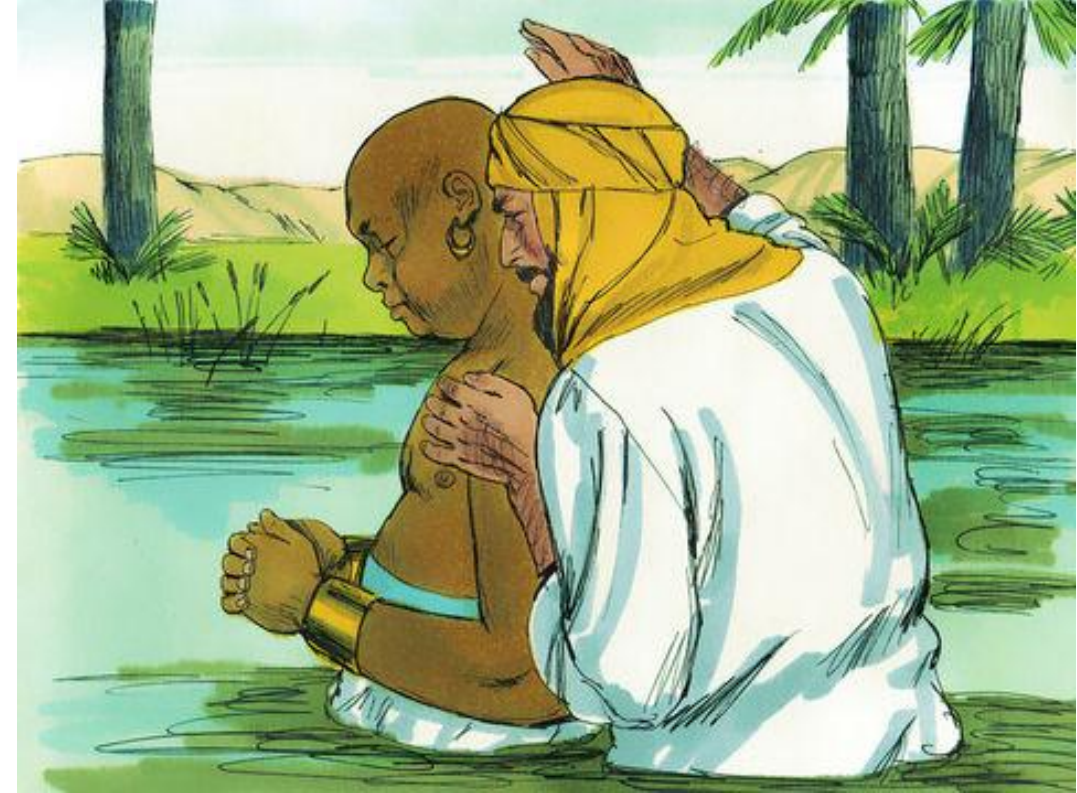
The man said, "No, I don't. I don't have a teacher."
He asked Philip to sit with him in the cart.





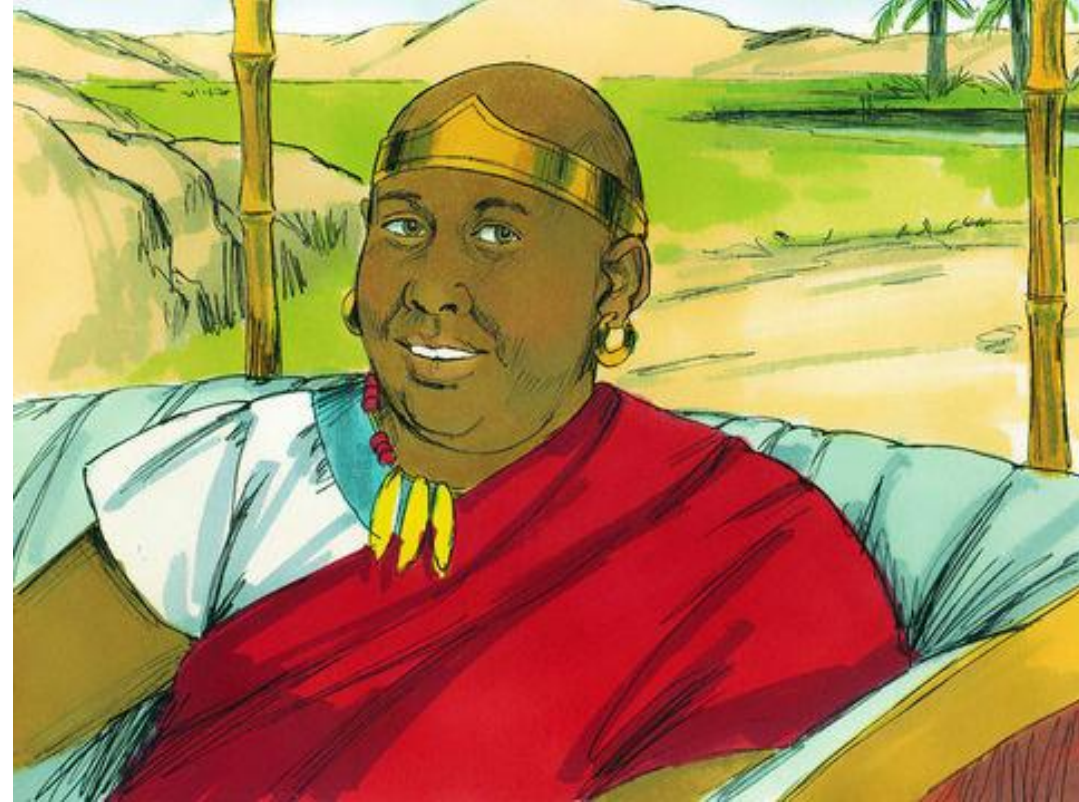
Then Philip began to teach the Word of God. He told the man all about Jesus. Later, they came to some water.

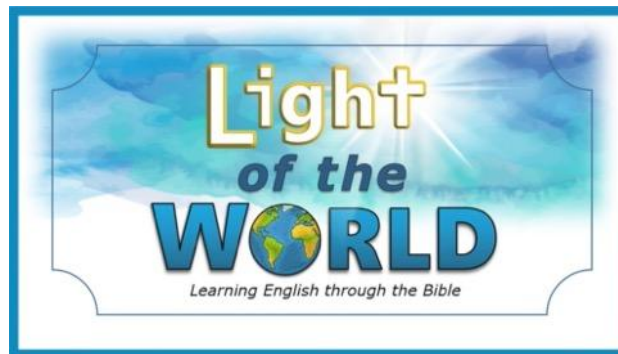
